In 2006 she fell in love again when she became a grandmother. She absolutely adored her three grandchildren, Mia, Noah, and Lex. She was a fantastic, doting grandmother always planning activities, playing games, baking cookies, and reading books. She could always be counted on to attend

every ballgame, school program, golf match, or play. They were truly the joy of her life.

In 2013 she achieved a lifelong dream when she published her novel Sand in Tuscany. This story was inspired by her parents and is the inspiration for the documentary, The Final Word of World War II. Currently a screen play has been written from her novel with hopes of a Motion Picture being made.
