“ Dear Reverend Jamie Perigo and Perigo Family,
My name is Rayburn Mac Greene. I am the oldest grandson of Mac Eakes. I live in Florida now and have not seen your beloved Daddy since my grandmother’s (Sue Eakes) funeral in 2001. I occasionally peruse the Sand Mountain Reporter from time to time just to see what’s going on back home and today I saw where Brother Perigo (as PawPaw always referred to him) had gone on to be with the Lord. I just wanted to send a letter to you to let you know what a profound impact this great man had on my life. My granddaddy loves telling the story of his conversion in August of 1969 in a truck shed at Goldkist Chicken Plant in Boaz Alabama. At the time, he was using drugs, selling drugs, cheating on his wife, and was about as lost as a sinner could be. Your daddy kept telling him about Jesus and sharing the gospel with him about every chance he could. One night, your dad left an open Bible right where Pawpaw would be, and the scripture was
“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved”. Romans 10:9
My grandfather blew it off again but something happened that night. He went home and during the night he had a dream that he was falling into a large black pit and the fall kept going and going and going. He said that he knew at that moment that God was telling him that if he didn’t run to Him that he would be lost and end up in Hell forever. He went back to work, found your dad and accepted Jesus. He immediately came home and told Mawmaw. She thought he had lost his mind, but soon found out that he had experienced something powerful and life changing. She soon received Christ herself and together they raised their three children in church. The obedience of your father sharing the Faith has had far reaching effects. My mother (Karen) is a Christian and she raised me to love Jesus and follow him. I am married now and have three daughters and they are being raised in a Christian home. I am a head football coach here in Florida and have had led many young men to the Lord over the years. This and so much more can be traced back to James Perigo.

I have such fond memories of being a little boy attending Sneads Chapel. I remember your father would call me "Rufus" and would let me sing in church. He was such a wonderful example of a Godly man. I am tearing up as I type this because he meant so much to me. Please accept my deepest condolences for your loss. I know we all look forward to that happy family reunion in Heaven, when we'll all be together again.
