Micaela and her family fled Guatemala in 1983 due to Guatemala's Civil War. She came to the United States to provide safety for her family. Micaela spent many years working as a crop picker in Plant City, Florida and spent the last 10 years of her working career at Tyson Foods.

Micaela was known for her contagious smile, and her kind and lively spirit.

A funeral service will be held on Wednesday, May 6, 2020 at Albertville Memorial Chapel at 12:30 p.m. followed by burial at Memory Hill Cemetery at 2:00 p.m.
